Spring Managed Care Forum Approved for CCM, CPUR/CPUM and CMCN Credits

Richmond, VA – In addition to nursing continuing education credits, The Spring Managed Care Forum has been approved for 15 credits towards the following credentials: CCM, CPUR/CPUM and CMCN. An application has also been submitted for CPHQ credits.

The Commission for Case Management Certification sent official approval stating that “This activity has been approved for 15 contact hours towards CCM recertification requirements.” Tom Tennant of McKesson officially approved the conference for CPUR/CPUM credits by stating, “This activity can be used for submission of up to 15 contact hours toward recertification for Certified Professional Utilization Review and/or Certified Professional Utilization Management.” The American Board of Managed Care Nurses (ABMCN) also accredits this program for 15 continuing education units towards recertification for the certification in managed care nursing (CMCN).

This program was also submitted to NAHQ for approval of 15 credits towards CPHQ accreditation. The American Association of Managed Care Nurses (AAMCN), which co-sponsors this conference, hopes to receive approval of the CPHQ accreditation within six weeks.
